In fact, the water is so pure it can be repurposed for irrigation instead of dumped when it's time for a refill.

The ACE Salt Water Sanitization System for hot tubs produces four powerful natural oxidants: MPS non-chlorine shock, ozone, hydrogen peroxide, and natural chlorine—the kind that does not have the offensive chlorine odor, taste, and eye irritation. This system ultimately lowers the cost of maintenance significantly as well as the amount of labor needed for general upkeep. The integrated, easy-to-operate control panel conducts automatic salt tests for you.
